Sometimes, as the relative or close friend of a patient, you may be concerned about that patient. Seeing a doctor

Surgeries run at various times throughout the day from 8.00am to 6.00pm.

How to register

Registration and personal history forms are available at reception.

You can also e-mail us with your name and address and we will send you the relevant forms. After completion of both forms you will then be registered with us. Generally, doctors take new patients in rotation, but you may register with a doctor of your choice should you have a preference. If you do have a particular preference, please advise reception.

Once the forms have been completed and we have registered you on our system, you will be able to make an appointment. On registering you will be invited to make an appointment for a new patient medical with our practice nurse.

Booked appointments

To arrange an appointment please use the Appointments Line 01225 444487.

Whenever possible, please make an appointment with your registered doctor, but, if the problem is urgent, and your doctor is unavailable because he/she is fully booked or away from the practice, you will be offered an appointment with another doctor.

Most appointments are of ten minutes duration. If you need to discuss more than one problem with

the doctor, and feel that ten minutes will be insufficient, please mention this at the time of booking so that you can be allocated a longer appointment. Please note that it is the patient's responsibility to cancel in good time any appointments no longer required.

Open surgeries

These are non-bookable, walk-in-and-wait surgeries from 8.30 to 10.30 am, and 2.00 to 4.00 pm, Mondays to Fridays.

They operate on a 'first come, first served' basis and there is no need to phone first – simply turn up at the surgery. Please try to restrict these consultations to a single problem. Whilst it is not possible to request a particular doctor, if you require either a male or female doctor, we endeavour to accommodate this.

Home visits

Examinations can be carried out more fully in the surgery but, if it is impossible to attend the surgery, please contact us as early as possible (ideally before 10.30am). After taking basic details, your doctor's secretary will pass the message to your doctor who may telephone to offer immediate advice and to make appropriate arrangements to deal with the problem.

Special examinations

Please inform the receptionist if you need to book an appointment for a special medical examination, as often a longer appointment is necessary. Side rooms are available for anyone in physical or emotional distress, and again please inform the receptionist.

When surgery is closed

and explains how a doctor can be contacted outside normal hours. (Please note the out of hours service is the responsibility of the local Primary Care Trust.)
